"As He Began To Sink...."

Lesson Text: Matthew 14:28-30 (CEB).

I. The Scene- Vs. 22-27.

— "Immediately" After Feeding The 5,000 In 14:14-21, He Sends The Disciples On Ahead To Go To The Other Side By Boat. Jesus Goes Up On The Mountain To Pray. The Disciples Encounter A Great Storm. Jesus Walks On The Water At Night. The Disciples Believe Jesus Is A "Ghost!" Jesus Speaks To Them, And Says, "Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid."

II. Some Factors That Caused Peter To Sink.

- Not The Difficulty Of The Task- Vs. 29.
 - By This Time, Peter Had Seen Jesus Do Many Miracles.
 - Luke 5:4-8; Luke 5:13; 7:13-15; and the Feeding Of The 5,000!
 - Peter Realized By His Time With Jesus— Jesus Had The Power To Grant Him The Power To Walk On Water Too.
 - Matthew 19:26.

Not A Lack Of Interest Or Effort- Vs. 28-29.

- Despite The Fact That Men Cannot Walk On Water— Peter Asked The Lord...
- It Is An Interesting Fact To Note: None Of The Other Disciples Asked To Do The Same!
- Sometimes Peter Is Called "Impetuous Peter" For Such Actions As This One.
 - For Being The First To Act Or Speak On certain Occasions- Matthew 16:22; 17:4.

Not Presumption- Vs. 28.

- Some Might Be Tempted To Make This Charge Against Peter— But Not So!
- Jesus Often Commended Those Who Showed Great Faith- Matthew 8:10; 9:2.
- Peter's Faith Is What Led Him To Ask Jesus!

- But Rather, Peter Saw The Wind And The Waves! Vs. 30.

- He Shifted His Focus To The Wind & The Waves
- The "Boisterous Waves" (NKJB) Became Bigger To Him Than Jesus.

- He Took His Eyes Off Jesus- Vs. 30.

- Peter Should Have Kept Looking At Jesus And Remember Who Jesus Is!
- He Should Have Realized Jesus Would Keep Him Safe! Matthew 8:23-27.

And Peter's Faith Became Little & Doubtful- Vs. 31.

- Fear and Doubt Are The Opposite Of Faith. Matthew 21:21; James 1:6.
- How Satan Attacks Our Faith! Ephesians 6:16.

III. What Keeps Our Faith From Sinking Today?

- 1. Stay Close To Jesus! How? By Focusing On Him! 2 Corinthians 3:18.
- 2. Do What Builds Up Our Faith. Matthew 17:19-21. Faith Can Grow!
- 3. Never Take Our Eyes Off Jesus! Hebrews 12:1-2.
