I. By Giving Value & Purpose To Our Lives.

- The world says: "Only the beautiful people, the talented, the gifted, the successful are what we call winners and are to be praised and given value."
- But God says: "All men have value!" John 3:16; Romans 5:8; Luke 16:15
 - 1. We Are Valuable Regardless of Our Lack Of Talent & Ability: 1 Cor. 1:26
 - 2. We Are Valuable Despite Our Weaknesses Or Sins: Hebrews 4:14-16.
 - 3. We Are Valuable Because of Our Faith: James 2:5.
 - 4. We Are Valuable Because We Are His: 1 John 3:1.
 - **5.** And Because We Are His... We Have Real Purpose & Meaning: **Ephesians 2:10; Matthew 6:33; Ecclesiastes 12:13.**

(Soul winning, people of prayer, worshipper of God, & citizen of the kingdom)

II. By Giving Us The Wisdom To Find Happiness.

- Proverbs 3:13 Where? Psalm 128:1; 119:104
- Not in circumstances, riches, and temporary accolades

We can find happiness, peace, & joy in every relationship by following God's word:

- 1. By following the "Golden Rule" Matthew 7:12.
- 2. By following after the "fruits of the Spirit" Galatians 5:22-23.
- 3. Following Jesus makes us content, at peace, joyful, and loving.

III. By Giving Us Freedom From Sin.

- Sin Makes us miserable:

Genesis 3:8-10 Brings guilt, shame, and unhappiness!

- All because Satan doesn't want you to be happy!
 - John 8:32-36; Romans 6:7-11 (The gospel gives us freedom!)
- How does getting rid of the "old man" make us happy? (**Ephesians 4:17-5:2**).

IV. By Giving Us Hope For The Future.

- -Psalm 146:5.
- Imagine our life with only this world.... with all of its problems, troubles, pain, and suffering— with no hope of it getting better!
 1 Corinthians 15:19.
- God gives us hope in an eternal life beyond this world of sorrows!
- Colossians 1:3-6; Titus 3:7; 2 Corinthians 4:16-5:1.
