Lesson Text: **John 14:8-13.**

II. The Role That Jesus Has In Being The Father’s Son.

- Jesus— Creator. **Colossians 1:12-19; John 1:3.**
 - Not “everything [other] things were created...” (New World Translation).
 - **Genesis 1:26; Genesis 9:6; James 3:9.**
 - Jesus- “the Beginning of the creation of God” in **Revelation 3:14.**

“one who or that which constitutes an initial cause—‘first cause, origin.’ ἡ ἀρχὴ τῆς κτίσεως τοῦ θεοῦ ‘the origin of what God has created’ Re 3:14. It is also possible to understand ἀρχή in Re 3:14 as meaning ‘ruler’ (see 37.56). (Louw, J. P., & Nida, E. A. (1996). In Greek-English lexicon of the New Testament: based on semantic domains (electronic ed. of the 2nd edition., Vol. 1, p. 778).

- Jesus—Our Savior. **Isaiah 43:11; Titus 2:13-14.**
 - **2 Peter 1:1; 2 Peter 1:11.**
- Jesus—Our King. **Revelation 19:11-16; 17:14.**
 - **Hebrews 1:8.**
 - **Hebrews 1:8 (NWT)** ”But about the Son, he says: ‘God is your throne forever and ever, and the scepter of your Kingdom is the scepter of uprightness’”
 - But This A Quotation From: **Psalms 45:6.**
 - **Luke 1:31-33.**
- Jesus—The Judge Of All. **Romans 2:16; Acts 10:42; 2 Corinthians 5:10.**
 - Jesus Said While He Was Here On Earth- **John 5:22-23.**
- Jesus—“The First And The Last.” **Revelation 1:7-8; 10-18; 22:12-13.**
 - The Father Said This In **Isaiah 44:6.** The Same Is True Of Jesus!

Conclusion: 1 Timothy 3:16.
