- To Preach The Gospel Of The Coming Kingdom- **Luke 4:43; Matthew 13:11.**
- To Prepare The Twelve Apostles- **John 17:14-19.**
- To Give Himself For Our Sins- **John 17:4—19:30; Mark 10:45; Hebrews 10:11-18.**
- To Establish His Church And Kingdom- **Matthew 16:18-19; John 18:36-38.**

III. It Is Finished.

- What Does That Means To You And I Today? Not What Many Are Teaching Today!
- Many Are Teaching That Jesus Finished Everyone’s Work For Them— Not So!
 - Salvation Is On An Individual Basis- **Philippians 2:12; 2 Timothy 4:7-8.**
- We Are Not Adding Anything To The Finished Work Of Christ— But Complying To It!
 - By Faith (**John 8:24**), Repentance From Sin (**Luke 13:3**), Confession Of Faith In Jesus (**Matthew 10:32**), Baptism Into Christ (**Mark 16:16**), & Faithful Obedience (**Revelation 2:10**).
