II. Matthew 1:21.

- Calvinism Makes Those Who Really Believe It Sad! But It Ain’t So!
- God Gave Us All Free-Will To Come To Him Or Reject Him
 - **John 1:11-12; Revelation 22:17.**
- As Gentiles, We Should Be Glad Like Cornelius’ Household And Rejoice!
- **Acts 13:42-48.**

IV. Ephesians 3:4.

- These Are Glad Words For Us Today! The Mystery Has Been Revealed- **3:5.**
- Paul Is Say To You, “When You Read, You Can Understand...”
- God Has Not Given Us A Message We Cannot Understand! Good News! **Romans 1:16-17.**
- I Can Understand:
 - How To Be Saved- **Acts 2:37-38.**
 - How To Follow Jesus Everyday- **John 10:27-28; 1 Peter 2:21.**
 - How I Should Prepare For Judgment- **2 Corinthians 5:10; 2 Peter 3:14.**
- I Can Follow God’s Word And Be Unashamed- **2 Timothy 2:15.**
