"Renewing Our Zeal For God"

Lesson Text: Romans 12:1-12.

I. Reminding Ourselves What Zeal Is.

 Zeal: "Ardor of feeling taking the form of jealousy, ardent affection of devotion, impassioned eagerness, ardor in pursuit, active interest, enthusiasm, fervor."

Romans 12:11, "not lagging behind in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;"

zeo (ζέω, 2204), "to be hot, to boil" (Eng. "zeal" is akin), is metaphorically used of "fervency" of spirit, Acts 18:25; Rom. 12:11. Vine's Complete Expository Dictionary of Old and New Testament Words (Vol. 2, p. 233).

III. Identifying Dangers To Our Zeal.

- Get Rid Of Sin- Hebrews 12:1.
- Get Rid Of "Time Stealers." **2 Timothy 2:4.** Too Much Entertainment, Leisure Time, Distractions...
- Eliminate Bad attitudes:

"That I don't have to be zealous." (Nominal, middle of the road Christian)

"I do enough for God at services on Sunday's and Wednesday's...."

"I don't want to get that involved."

"When I have time to be zealous, I will then."

IV. Refocusing Our Zeal For God.

- Add some time For God into our schedule.
- Make Personal Goals for this year:
 - Invite 5 people a week to services.
 - Read 3, 5, 7.... books this year on Bible Material.
