"The Awful Reality Of Hell"

Why are people NOT believing in the Bible subject of Hell? There is even a reluctance for preachers to preach on Hell, and Christians to hear lessons on it.

Why We Need to Preach on Hell:

- (1) It's in the Bible. (Acts 20:20; esp. vs. 27).
- (2) It Reminds Everyone What's Truly at Stake!
- (3) It Reminds Us How Much Christ Did at the Cross!
- (4) It Magnifies the Grace, Love, Mercy, Forgiveness, & Justice of God!

- (1) Hell is a place of Eternal Punishment— Matthew 25:31-46; Revelation 14:9-11.
- (2) Hell is a place of Eternal Fire.

 Matthew 25:41; Revelation 20:15 "lake of fire"
- (3) Hell is a place of Outer Darkness Matthew 8:12.
- (4) Hell is a place of Regret & Anguish Luke 16:24-25.
- (5) Hell is a place of No Hope— Matthew 25:46; Luke 16:26.

II. Who's Going There?

- (1) The Sinner Alienated From God— 1 Peter 4:17; 2 Thess. 1:7-9.
- (2) Those Who Love and Practice Sin—Revelation 21:8; 1 Cor. 6:9-10.
- (3) Those Who Are False Prophets/Teachers—Rev. 20:10; 2 Peter 2:1-2.
- (4) Those Who Add or Take Away From God's Word— Rev. 22:18-19.
- (5) The Hypocrite or Unfaithful Christian— Matt. 23:13-15; Heb. 10:29-31.
