"The Necessity Of Conviction"

Lesson Text: Romans 14:20-23 (NASB; NRSV).

I. The Meaning Of Conviction.

- Conviction: 1. The State Of Being Convinced. 2. A Strong Persuasion Or Belief.
- **Convict: 1.** *elencho* signifies (a) "to convict, confute, refute," usually with the suggestion of putting the convicted person to shame; see **Matt. 18:15**, where more than telling the offender his fault is in view; it is used of "convicting" of sin, **John 8:46**; **16:8**.

 - Not A Supernatural Working On Men, But An Appeal To Do Right.
 - Isaiah 1:18; Ezekiel 33:11.
 - How? Through Gospel Preaching- 1 Corinthians 1:18-21.
 - Conviction Of Sin Reaches To The Heart- Acts 2:37-41 Compared To Acts 7:51-60.
 - The Right Reaction Depends On The Soil Of The Heart- Luke 8:11-15; 1 Cor. 1:22-24.
- Acts 24:25. Felix Trembled Out Of Conviction, But Not Converted To The Truth.
- 1 Corinthians 5:1-8-2 Corinthians 7:8-11.
- Jude 14-15. One Day Convicted Sinners Will Be Punished By God.
 - This Is Why We Do Not Want To Be On The Wrong Side Of God's Justice!

III. The Need To Develop Strong Convictions Or Beliefs.

- We Must Be Convicted Or Be Convinced Of Truth. Hebrews 11:1.
- What Happens When We Don't Have Convictions?
 - Truth Becomes Less Important To Us.
 - We Are Not Equipped To Work In God's Kingdom Properly.
 - What Would We Teach Others? No Convictions = No Message.
 - What Kind Of Influence Do We Have On The World?
- Many Look At Christianity At Large As Being Conviction-less:
 - "Doesn't Matter What You Believe." "We Shouldn't Speak About What's Right Or Wrong."
 - "Preacher, Don't Step On Anyone's Toes." "Just Preach General Truth, Don't Get Specific."
