"The Dangers Of Prejudice"

Lesson Text: 1 Timothy 5:21 (NKJB; NET; NASB).

I. The Prejudice Of Our World Today.

- Racial & Cultural Prejudice. (Black, White, Indian, Japanese, Chinese, Jews, Or Mexican....)
 - Evidenced By Racial Slurs, Racial Divide, Unfair Treatment, Violence Toward Races & Cultures...
 - Black Lives Matter (All Lives Matter!), Discrimination & Reverse Discrimination....
- **Economic Prejudice.** (Rich, Middle Class, Or Poor...).
 - The Haves Versus The Have Nots.... Jealousy Over Possessions And The Flaunting Of Such!
- Gender Prejudice. (Males Versus Females....).
 - Men Who Hate Women And Women Who Hate Men.
- Intellectual Prejudice. (Intelligent, Average, Or Below Average....).
 - The Wisdom Of This World Often Brings Arrogance & Contempt For Others Less Intelligent...
- Political Prejudice. (Democrat, Republican, Socialist, Or Independent).
 - Cruel Mocking, Political Satire, Violence, & Discrimination/Unfair Treatment.
- Religious Prejudice. (Religiously Divided People Can Act Very Unkind To One Another!).
 - Hatred, Prejudicial Slurs, Jokes, & Even Violence Toward Religious People....
- These All Have No Place In The Life Of A Christian!
 - As We Know The Source The Devil! Titus 3:2-3.

II. The Prejudice Of Biblical Times.

 - The Jews On Loving Your Neighbor, Quote From "Lessons From The Parables" pg. 68.
- John 4:9, Jews And Samaritans Had a Long Standing Animosity After The Return.
 - John 4:4, "And he must needs go through Samaria." (KJB).

Travel through Samaria was not geographically necessary; the normal route for Jews ran up the east side of the Jordan River (Transjordan). Although some take the impersonal verb had to $(\delta\epsilon\hat{\imath}, dei)$ here to indicate logical necessity only, normally in John's Gospel its use involves God's will or plan (3:7, 3:14, 3:30, 4:4, 4:20, 4:24, 9:4, 10:16, 12:34, 20:9).
