# "What God Says About Our Obedience"

Lesson Text: Deuteronomy 6:1-9.

# I. Our Obedience Is Still Required To Be Faithful.

- Contrary To What Men May Say Today, God Still Wants Our Obedience!
- Misconception: God Demanded Obedience In The Old Testament, But In The New Testament Age He Doesn't Care About Obedience Anymore.
- But Has God Changed Mind About Obedience? Why Would He?
- John 14:15; Matthew 7:21; Luke 6:46; Hebrews 5:8-9.
- False Doctrines:
  - 1. Imputed Righteousness (Imputed Obedience?). Then Why 1 John 1:6-9?
  - 2. To Take Scriptures About The Law Of Moses Not Over Us Today, And Using

Them To Imply That All Law Has Been Done Away With Is Wrong. Galatians 2:16; 3:24.

- 3. Being Diligent In Keeping God's Word Is Legalism. 2 Timothy 2:5.
  - Real Legalism Is Doing God's Will Without Our Heart Being In It. **Deuteronomy 10:12-13.**
- We Either Obey Christ's Commandments Today Or The Alternative Disobedience!
  - 2 Thessalonians 3:14-15; Hebrews 13:17.

# II. Our Obedience Is Not To Hurt Us, But For Our Good Always.

- Deuteronomy 6:24. Has God Ever Commanded Anything That Would Harm Us?
- Deuteronomy 7:1-5. God's Commandments Were Protecting Them From Evil.
- Today, Christ's Commands Keep Us Safe From Hurtful Practices.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:1-9.

# III. Our Obedience Brings Us Closer To Him.

- We Have A Connection To God Through Obeying His Word- 1 John 5:1-3.
- Our Relationship With Jesus Is Based On Following Him In Keeping His Words:
  - John 14:21-24; John 15:3; 1 John 2:3-4.
- God's Commands Are Given To Make Us More Like God:
  - Matthew 5:48; 1 Peter 1:14-15; Luke 6:40.

# IV. Our Obedience Makes Us Distinctive From Others.

- Deuteronomy 4:3-10. The Israelites Were Different From All Other Nations.
- 1 Peter 2:4-11. We Are Different From The World By Obeying God.

# V. Our Obedience Will Be Rewarded.

- By Obeying The Gospel, We Are Saved From Our Sins.
  - Romans 6:17-18; 1 Peter 1:22.
- The Ultimate Reward Is Heaven-
  - Matthew 25:21; 25:23; Revelation 22:14.
