- **Evidence:** The available body of facts or information indicating whether a belief or proposition is true or valid.

  - Jesus Was Bold & Uncompromising, Are We? **Matthew 21:12-13; Acts 4:13.**
  - Jesus Was Pure In All His Ways, Are We? **John 19:6; Philippians 2:15-16.**
  - Jesus Was Always About His Father's Business- **Luke 2:49; 1 Corinthians 15:58.**
