"Fishing And Converting The Lost"

Now it came to pass that a group existed that called themselves fishermen and there were many fish in the waters about them. In fact, the whole area was surrounded by streams and lakes and the fish were hungry. Week after week and month after month and year after year the group that called themselves "fishermen" met in meetings and talked about those called to fish, the abundance of fish, and how they might go about fishing.

They hired staff and held many meetings to define fishing, to defend fishing, and to decide what new streams should be thought about.

But one thing the staff and the committee members did not do—they did not fish!

Large, elaborate training centers were built, whose original and primary purpose was to teach fishermen how to fish. Over the years, courses were offered on the needs of fish, the nature of fish, how to find fish, and the psychological effects of fishing. Those who taught had doctorates in "Fisheology." But the teachers did not fish. They only taught about fishing.

Further, the fishermen built large printing houses to publish fishing guides. Presses were kept busy day and night to produce material solely devoted to fishing methods. A speakers bureau was organized to schedule special speakers on fishing.

After one stirring meeting entitled, "The Necessity of Fishing," two young men left the meeting and actually did some fishing and one of them actually caught two fish! He was honored for his great catch and was scheduled to appear at all the big meetings to tell how he did it. So he quit fishing in order to have the time to tell his experiences to the other fishermen.

Now it is true that many of the fishermen sacrificed and put up with all kinds of difficulties. Some lived near the water and had to put up with the smell of dead fish. Some had to endure the ridicule of some who made fun of these fishermen's clubs because they claimed to be fishermen, but they did not fish.

And they wondered about those who thought it was of little use to attend meetings and talk about fishing. I mean, after all, were they not following the Master, who said, "Come and I will make you fishers of men."? Yet it did not make sense. Can we rightfully call a person a fisherman, if year after year he never catches a fish?

Can a person really be following Jesus if he is not fishing?

"The Church And Its Treasury"

Lesson Text: 1 Corinthians 16:1-2.

I. What Some May Say About The Common Treasury.

- Some Want To Deny A Pooling Of Funds- AKA "Church Treasury."
- Quote: "It is true that the disciples were instructed to treasure up some things, "And concerning the collection that (is) for the saints, as I directed to the assemblies of Galatia, so also ye— do ye; on every first (day) of the week, let each one of you lay by him, treasuring up whatever he may have prospered, that when I may come then collections may not be made."
 (1 Corinthians 16:1-2 YLT). But you cannot term this, "Church treasury" and form a doctrine with rules and guidelines attached with it. They had no "Church treasury", as you say. The expression, "Church treasury, or, "Common collection" did not come out of the mouth of God."
 - Possible Reasons Why:
 - 1. They Don't Like The Practice.
 - 2. They Like To Argue Against "Church of Christ Traditions."
 - 3. They Have Intentions To Pull People Away From God's Arrangement.

II. The Treasury In The Old Testament.

- 1 Chronicles 29:8; Ezra 2:69; Nehemiah 7:70-71. God would Not ask them to do His work without the resources and Money to do so!
- **Nehemiah 13:5**, Even the first-fruits, tithes, and freewill offerings constituted treasury, and such were given a storage room or treasury in the Temple- **Malachi 3:10**.
 - Mark 12:41-44; Matthew 27:6- The Jews Continued To Have a Treasury.
 - John 13:27-29- Jesus and the disciples had a treasury.

III. The Treasury In The New Testament.

- Acts 2:42- "Fellowship" (Romans 15:26; 2 Corinthians 9:13).
- Acts 4:34-37- "and laid it at the apostles' feet," (Vs. 35).
- Acts 6:1-6- Men appointed to serve.
- Acts 11:29-30- The Judean Churches had treasuries.
- 1 Corinthians 16:1-2- "in store" literally, "Put into the treasury."

IV. Answering Critics Of A Collection—Treasury Today.

- Some say this collection was ONLY FOR EMERGENCY BENEVOLENCE PURPOSES— Not for Evangelism or for the Support of Preachers....
- But It was FOR more than just Benevolence- 1 Corinthians 9:1-14;
 2 Corinthians 11:8; Philippians 4:15-16; 1 Timothy 5:9; 5:16.
- God has given the church a great Work to perform That also necessitates the resources and money needed to carry out our mission!

I. The Kingdom Of Darkness Vs. The Kingdom Of Light.

- Colossians 1:13- Relates To The Nature of the Two Kingdoms:
 - Satan's "Power of darkness." "Domain." "Authority."
 Ephesians 6:12; John 3:19; Luke 22:53.
 - Christ's Kingdom- "The kingdom of His beloved Son." (NASB, ESV, RSV).
 1 John 1:5; Acts 26:17-18; 1 Peter 2:9.
- Satan's Worldly, Carnal Kingdom- 1 John 2:15-16; Satan's Territory
- Christ's Spiritual Kingdom- John 18:36; 2 Corinthians 10:4 (RSV); Rom. 14:17.

II. The Rulership Of Satan Vs. The Rulership Of Christ.

IV. Rules & Laws Of Satan's Kingdom Vs. Christ's Kingdom.

- Satan's Rules & Laws- **1 John 3:4** "Lawlessness" reigns! anomia (ἀνομία, 458), lit., "lawlessness" (a, negative, nomos, "law"), is used in a way which indicates the meaning as being lawlessness or wickedness. Its usual rendering in the NT is "iniquity," which lit. means unrighteousness. (Vine's Complete Expository Dictionary of Old and New Testament Words (Vol. 2, p. 326)..
 - Christ's Rules And Laws- John 14:15; 1 John 3:22; 5:2-3.

V. The Temporary Kingdom Vs. The Everlasting Kingdom.

- Satan's Kingdom Will Not Last- **Hebrews 2:14; Revelation 12:12; 1 John 2:17a.**
- Christ's Kingdom Will Be Everlasting- 2 Peter 1:11; Daniel 2:44; 1 John 2:17b.
