  - Resistance To God's Ways Is Futile & Counter-productive To Us. Acts 9:5; 26:14.
  - Anything But Total Surrender And Humble Submission To God Is Foolish!
  - "With God we may not strive: But to bow down the willing neck, And bear the yoke, is wise; To kick against the pricks will prove A perilous emprise." —Pind. Pyth. ii. 173.
- James 4:7- But Resistance Is Commanded By God In Reference Of The Devil.
  - It Is What Jesus, Our Example Did In Matthew 4:1-10.
  - Resistance Means Not Giving The Devil Any Ground- Ephesians 4:27.
  - Resistance Means Being Properly Equipped- Ephesians 6:11-12.
  - Resistance Means Being On Guard, On The Alert! 1 Peter 5:8-9.
