"The Names For The Devil Pt. 2"

Lesson Text: Matthew 13:39.

I. The Devil.

- Διάβολος (Diabolos) meaning "slanderer, adversary." It Is The Greek Word For The Hebrew Satan.
- In The Old Testament... "The name Devil is not found in the Old Testament, but the figure of Satan is specifically mentioned in 1 Chronicles, Job, and Zechariah."
 - It Is Used 34 Times In The New Testament; The Second Most Used Term For Satan.
 - The First Time The Term Devil Is Used In Matthew 4:1.
 - Interesting To Note That Matthew Uses The Name Devil Frequently, But Mark Never Does Once.
 - The Devil Has The Role Of Accuser- Revelation 12:10.
 - Slander and Accusations Are His Weapons Against Us! Job 1:8-11; 2:3-5.
 - The Devil Is Our Adversary- 1 Peter 5:8-9.
 - We Must Not Give The Devil An Opportunity In Our Lives- Ephesians 4:27 (ESV; NIV).
 - We Must Avoid The Reproach And Snares Of The Devil- 1 Timothy 3:6-7.
 - The Devil Is Out To Destroy Us, But Jesus Wants To Save Us From Him- Acts 10:38.

II. The Tempter.

- The Major Work of The Devil/Satan! What We Find Him Involved In Throughout The Scriptures.
- This Name Referring To Satan Is Found Two Times: Matthew 4:3; 1 Thessalonians 3:5.
- The Purpose Of Temptation Is To Lead Us To Sin & Death- James 1:14-15.
- Ultimately, To Lead Us Away From Serving God- 1 Thessalonians 3:5.
- The Devil Uses Fleshly/Worldly Desires To Allure Us To Do Evil.
 - 1 John 2:16; Matthew 4:1-10.
- Satan Cannot Force Us To Do Evil Against Our Will (1 Corinthians 10:13).
- Is It A Sin To Be Tempted By The Devil? No! But Giving In To The Temptation Is!
 - Luke 22:2-3; John 13:2; Acts 5:3. The Only Way Satan Can Control Us Is When We Say Yes!
 - That's Why It's So Important To Say No, And Resist Sin! James 4:7.

III. The Serpent.

- How Do We Know The Devil Or Satan Was In The Garden Of Eden? Revelation 12:9.
- The Devil Chose The Most Subtle Form Of A Serpent To Deceive Eve- Gen. 3:1; 2 Cor. 11:3.
- The Devil Is Known As One Who Deceives- 2 Corinthians 11:13-15.
- The Devil, And His Followers, Use Lies To Deceive Us- Revelation 2:9; Matthew 3:7; 12:34.

IV. The Great Dragon.

- The Devil Is Referred To As A Dragon, 13 Times In The Book Of Revelation Only.
- The Devil Is First Named As The Great Dragon In Revelation 12:1-6.
 - The Devil Makes War With God's People- Revelation 12:7-12.
 - The Dragon Persecutes God's People- Revelation 12:13-17.
- The Dragon, Or Satan Is Bound By God And Overcome! **Revelation 20:1-2.**
- Ultimately, The Devil Loses In The Judgment Day! Matthew 25:41; vs. 46.
